RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

If you're **NON-CATHOLIC**, you may be curious about, perhaps even scandalized by, Abraham's faith. Be an **ENQUIRER**, to discover the same faith that Abraham had and learn that with God on your side, no one can be against you (cf. Romans 8:31)! As an enquirer, there is no pressure on you to become a Catholic and you are free to withdraw at any stage of this initiation.

If you're **CATHOLIC**, invite family and friends to be enquirers. Even if you don't bring anyone, you can still be a **COMPANION** to the enquirers.
