1. Leadership Capability Worktreat—Following Jesus: A call to Action. This servant leadership programme will look closely at what Jesus did in growing his ministry and how he influenced and transformed his team.

2. Review of Life (ROL) Workshop

The 'Review of Life' (ROL) Method is a method of formation and a tool to read the "sign of times". These workshop will provide an introduction to the method, followed by an exercise using the three steps in the ROL - "See, Judge, Act" to analyse and reflect on an actual situation.
