## PRESENCE : THE MYSTERY OF THE EUCHARIST

"Jesus said to them, 'Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of man and drink his blood, you have no life in you . . . He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood abides in me, and I in him'" (John 6:53-56).

The feast of Corpus Christi or Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ on 3 June 2018 celebrates the real presence of the body and blood of Jesus Christ, the Son of God, in the Eucharist.

Although the Eucharist appears to be simple bread and wine, it is actually the “source and summit” of the Christian life. Presence: The Mystery of the Eucharist explores the truth and beauty of Christ’s real presence in the Eucharist, from its origins in Sacred Scripture to its profound role in the life of the Church and its members. The Eucharist is the crescendo of the entire story of salvation.
