### PARISH MISSION UPDATE—Home Visits and NCC Masses

From Monday 9th July, home visits shall start. The first NCC to be visited is Marine Crescent and after the home visits from Monday to Thursday, they shall have their NCC Mass on **Friday, 13th July**. The Marine Crescent volunteers have contacted or shall be contacting the families on details such as their date and time slots for the visits and also details of the NCC Mass. The NCC Mass is open to all families in Marine Crescent NCC, including those who are not having home visits. The last home visit week for our Parish Mission is from Monday 1st October to Thursday 4th October, with the last NCC Mass on Friday 5th October.

Volunteers from the various NCCs are in the process of contacting their NCC families about home visit scheduling and NCC Mass details. As there are many homes to be visited across the parish, please help our volunteers by responding promptly to their calls and also do try to fit your schedule to the timings arranged for your home visit and NCC Mass.

### Non-Resident Parishioners

One of the outreach initiatives of our Parish Mission, is a bespoke Mass for the 600 Non-Resident Parishioner (NRP) families who regularly worship at Holy Family. For these families, **Masses with special family blessings will be held on 14th September, 28th September and 12th October (all Fridays) at 8 p.m.**, followed by fellowship in our Church Canteen. Our volunteers will call you in July and during the call you will be invited to attend one of the 3 common theme masses. Do make time for the bespoke Mass and fellowship with your fellow NRPs in your neighbourhood. Special petition boxes will be placed during the Masses for your intentions to be offered during the Masses.
