PARISH MISSION UPDATE — HOME VISITS AND NCC MASSES

As there are many homes to be visited across the parish, please help our volunteers by responding promptly to their calls and also do try to fit your schedule to the timings arranged for your home visit and NCC Mass.

NON-RESIDENT PARISHIONERS

One of the outreach initiatives of our Parish Mission is a bespoke Mass for the 600 Non-Resident Parishioner (NRP) families who regularly worship at Holy Family. For these families, Masses with special family blessings will be held on **14th September, 28th September and 12th October (all Fridays) at 8.00pm**, followed by fellowship in our Church Canteen.
