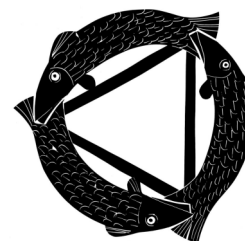

HAPPY FATHERS' DAY

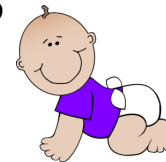
