The Parish Assembly will be held on 24<sup>th</sup> July 2016 at Katong Convent Primary School and this year, 2 important issues are being considered which calls for your participation. **The first being the Vision Mission and Values of our Parish.** In this regard, there has been 2 stages of consultation the initial input and the survey already held. The results of the survey are being collated and will be discussed and formulated at the Parish Assembly and would need you to assist in this undertaking. **The second, is the renovation** upon which our Church is embarking to accommodate the growing needs of our community. The intention is to convert 3 Sea Avenue into a residence for the priests and completely redevelop the existing Parish House into a 5-storey Parish Centre to house various facilities and rooms as required. The PPC will be gathering feedback through a survey and following the survey, we will provide this input to the architect and thereafter present a concept design at the Parish Assembly where you would be called to provide your further input in this development of the parish. **Your views are important on both these issues** and this is where we can all gather to actively participate and take a joint responsibility for these important aspects of our parish's life. **So please set aside 24<sup>th</sup> July 2016 at 2pm. In the upper room, Christ said the words of consecration and gave himself to his disciples in the first Eucharist. Elijah carried the widow's son to the upper room, called out to the Lord, and "he revived." "The word of God comes truly from your mouth," the widow testified.
