## FURTHER CONSULTATION AND INPUT ON THE PARISH CENTRE

A survey was held earlier in the year and based on the input obtained and in consultation with the architects who sought to make best use of space, as permissible under the prevailing laws, a concept plan was put before the Parish Assembly held on Sunday, 24th July 2016, at which some additional input had been provided. Given the importance of this endeavour and its long term impact on our Parish, it has been considered important to conduct a further consultation to ensure that all and any further input on this project be obtained.
