DEVELOPMENT OF NEW PARISH CENTRE

The renovation of 3 Sea Avenue is almost completed.

The priests of the parish hope to be able to move into the newly renovated premises by the middle of June.

We are hoping that the development of our new Parish Centre will commence in the first week of July.

Please note that while the new Parish Centre is being developed the parish secretariat and the priests' offices will be temporarily located at **3 Sea Avenue**.

The development of our new Parish Centre will involve the **closing of the entrance of Chapel Road**. Some car park spaces will be lost as hoarding around the construction site will be erected to ensure the utmost safety during the construction period.

There will therefore be a revised traffic flow within the car park area.

Vehicular entry will only be by Sea Avenue as the gate at Chapel Road will be closed due to construction works.

To ensure minimal disruption, new directional signs will also be drawn throughout the car park.

We beg our parishioners to kindly cooperate and collaborate with our Ministers of Hospitality who will be helping to guide and direct the traffic flow during the weekend Masses.

To help our parishioners familiarize themselves with the new traffic flow, we will begin implementing this system from next weekend, i.e. 16th and 17th June.

As the old Parish House will be torn down, the existing toilets in the building will no longer be available for use. Parishioners are kindly requested to use the existing toilets at Emmaus Centre, at the ground level of the main church, and at Level 4 Function Room.

Due to the revised traffic flow, parishioners attending Novena service only and whose cars are not in the designated parking lots are requested to leave the church premises by 5.30pm to enable those attending the 6pm Mass easy access.

We thank everyone for their cooperation and understanding during the period of construction and we apologise for any inconvenience caused.
