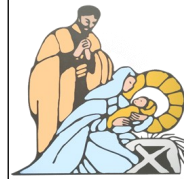

(1) Doctors and Nurses

We invite doctors and nurses to be present at the Mass and be prepared for any contingency.

(2) Drivers

We seek volunteers to accompany the homebound to and from Mass.

We aim to match drivers with homebound individuals living in the same vicinity if possible.

(3) Organizing Committee

We invite volunteers to form the organizing committee and oversee the logistics & publicity for this Mass. While experience in attending to the frail, elderly, sick & homebound is important, it is not a prerequisite. Members of the organizing committee will need to work closely with our Neighbourhood Christian Communities, Liturgical Ministry & Ministry to the Sick.
