This will allow you to do the Lenten recollection anytime during the season of Lent. It will also allow you and your Family members/Friends/Parish groups to do this as a Group in the comfort of your homes or any other suitable locations.

In particular, it would be meaningful to do the reflection ahead of the third Sunday of Lent, as this recollection guide is the "Living Water : Christ Encounter with the Samaritan Woman".

### ADULT CONFIRMATION 2020

Adults who have been baptised but not confirmed may apply for confirmation using the Church of the Holy Family Adult Confirmation Form available from the parish office. Submit the form to the office together with a copy of your baptism certificate (and marriage certificate, if married). Confirmation will be conferred by the Archbishop on **Sunday 3 May 2020 at 6.00 pm**.

To prepare for confirmation, applicants are required to attend **Adult Confirmation Preparation classes on 30 March, 6, 13 and 20 April in Room #04-04 from 7.30 pm to 9.30 pm**. Attendance is compulsory.
