

## *What You Need To Know*

### Resumption of Mass in Phase 2 commencing 11 July 2020

1. The number of parishioners attending each Mass is presently capped at 50 people.
2. You will be able to choose only one Mass during the month.
3. Prior registration is compulsory for every individual (including children).
4. Remember to bring your IC / BC / Work Pass with you for authentication of your registration.
5. "Check-in" begins 30 minutes before each mass
6. Mass schedule will be: -
  - a. Weekdays: 7:00 pm
  - b. Saturdays: 4:00 pm, 5:30 pm and 8:00 pm (Mandarin Mass)
  - c. Sundays: 8:00 am, 9:30 am, 11:00 am, 4:00 pm and 5:30 pm
  - d. Public Holidays: 8:30 am

#### **1. Prior Online Registration**

##### **Step 1 (27 June 2020 onwards):**

Register yourself at: [www.mycatholic.sg/register](http://www.mycatholic.sg/register) and choose "Holy Family" as the parish you will be attending. You will not have an option to switch to a different parish for the entire Covid-19 restriction period.

##### **Step 2: (07 July 2020 onwards)**

Log into <https://mycatholic.sg> and choose a mass that you would like to attend under "Mass Booking". Do note that you will only be allowed to select one mass within that calendar month.

#### **2. When you arrive in church on the appointed date/time:**

- a. Please check-in at the church location using SafeEntry system using your mobile phone.
- b. A volunteer will authenticate your registration for mass by scanning your IC / BC / Work Pass. Without this identification, you will not be able to enter for mass.
- c. You will also have your temperature taken. If your temperature is 38 degrees Celsius or higher, you will not be permitted entry into the church in accordance with MCCY guidelines.
- d. Face masks must be worn at all times.
- e. Hand sanitisers will be made available for use at the point of entry

#### **3. Movement to the designated seating area**

- a. Volunteers will be on hand to direct you to your allotted prayer space in the church main hall.
- b. Pew check-in is required once you are seated; simply use your phone to scan the QR code found on the pew, for easy access to the link. The pew location needed is indicated next to the QR code.
- c. You may be allowed to be seated in a group of up to 5 persons if you are together.
- d. Please maintain safe distancing of 1m (respect the cordoned off pews and seat markings as well).
- e. Avoid intermingling with other groups.

#### **4. Offertory Collection**

There will be no offertory collection; you may place your donations in the donation boxes either as you enter or as you leave church. Alternatively, you may donate to the Parish via PayNow.

#### **5. Process for Communion**

- a. Sanitize your hands
- b. Receive the host on the palm of your hand as usual
- c. Move to the assigned space at the side
- d. Lift up or remove your mask to consume the Body of Christ
- e. Return to your seat

#### **6. Movement out of church**

Worshippers must leave the church premises promptly after mass ends, without mingling with others. Upon leaving the church premises, worshippers should check out of the church premises using the SafeEntry system.

#### **7. Coming Soon ..**

Do note that the Grotto, Adoration Room and Columbarium will remain closed for the time being.
